

1. Are the House Party DVD screening kits free?

10. I am a Military mom whose son was killed in Iraq. Will this movie upset me and make me cry a lot?

The film deals with every issue military moms have dealt with during this very difficult time. There is a section in the film that deals with loss and it is emotional but not scary. Actually the comments we have received from other moms is that it is very therapeutic. Seeing the pain of others somehow seems to heal.

The movie will not upset you. We were very careful in choosing important images that only enhance the story, not images used for shock value. There is nothing in the film that is shocking.

11. Is there any humor?

Yes! Actually some of our moms are very funny! How can moms talk about their children and not have a funny story to tell? We have quite a few stories filled with love and humor.

12. How political does the film get?

Out of 94 minutes there is a small section of less than 10 minutes during which moms talk about their personal feelings about the war. The rest of the film deals with the challenges moms have to face while their kids are in harm's way.

13. Is any of the money that the film makes going to be donated to any charitable organizations?

Yes. As of right now, we will be donating portions of the film's proceeds to THE FISHER HOUSE, which is a home where families of wounded soldiers and marines stay while their children are receiving medical attention. We will also be donating to MARINEPARENTS.COM who have been a great support of thousands of parents during the difficult time of deployment. They send about 700 care packages a month to our troops among many other services.

14. Is this film like a Michael Moore's documentary?

No. This film is not picking a political side and it does not have a political agenda. However, this film is also not the opposite of a Michael Moore film. It represents both political views extremely fairly. Just check our amazing reviews.

15. Why didn't Cindy Sheehan participate in the film?

We did not want to include someone who was so politically charged. It would have changed the course of the film. Besides, Cindy's point of view is already represented in the film by other moms; moms that are not a daily part of the news, ordinary moms who are also struggling to deal with their loss.

16. What do you hope to accomplish with this film?
